

2. The Land Holding Commands concurred with the Army's implementing guidance titled *Army Stormwater Management Using Low Impact Development*. The incorporation of low impact development (LID) best management practices (BMPs) as a means to manage stormwater is effective starting in FY15 for Military Construction, Army, and all projects funded with other appropriations.

3. This guidance provides users with the information needed to ensure compliance with stormwater management requirements. HQDA developed LID planning, design and cost tools and provided training for master planners, design engineers and stormwater managers.
